March 21, 1947 - July 9, 2020

Barbara Nuckols Taylor was delivered to Ephrim (E.P.) and Robbie (Cheadle) Nuckols on Friday, March 21, 1947. She was the fifth child to join the family. Barbara grew up on Fifth Street in Anadarko, across the street from the church, playing with her siblings and friends.

Barbara accepted the Lord as her personal savior at an early age and committed herself to the Lord at First Baptist Church in Anadarko. The church was renamed Greater First Baptist and Barbara served in various youth ministry positions while being trained under the watchful eye of the Senior Seasoned Saints of the church.

She began her educational journey in the Anadarko School system where she graduated from the twelfth grade. Many lifelong relationships were established, grew, and were maintained with her 1965 graduation class.
