He then went to work with his brothers and closest friends at the zoo, followed by D's Wingz (where his infamous love for wings began). At the time of his passing, DeOnte' was fulfilling his childhood hobbies by working at an automotive accessory and detail shop.

Affectionately known as "King Koop", DeOnte' gave himself this moniker to honor his grandfather (K.O.), and he truly is regarded as such by his family and peers. No one will ever match the effect that he has had in our lives. Family was everything to him; his mother was his best friend, his father was
