Ivy Marie (Thompson) Hollander Lien was born November 21, 1924. She was born the third of four children to Frank Adrian Thompson and Mae (Wellhausen) Thompson in Rooks County, KS, near Webster, KS. Over the years, Ivy would call several different places home, starting with Wichita, KS, growing up then in the Cache, OK area for about 60 years. She later lived in Florida then Chickasha, OK.

Although Ivy would attend several schools in Kansas over the years, she would ultimately graduate from Plainview High School in Wichita, KS.

On April 7, 1945 Ivy Marie Thompson united in matrimony to Carl Hollander whom preceded her in death on February 20, 1986. Later in life, on March 26, 1995, Ivy united in matrimony to Irving Lien who also preceded her in death in April of 2002.
